- Upkeep of the engine room, pump rooms, steering gear compartment and all storage areas used for the storage of tools, spares and engineering equipment under the direction of the Chief Engineer.
- Assisting the Chief Engineer with organising maintenance and repairs so that the ship is able to maintain its schedule

- Previous experience of working as an Engineer on a sailing vessel (desirable)
