What does a Chief Engineer do onboard?

These are some of the duties that the Chief Engineer would be responsible for.

- Efficient operation, repair and maintenance of all mechanical and electrical machinery and associated equipment.
- Upkeep of the engine room, pump rooms, steering gear compartment and all storage areas used for the storage of tools, spares and engineering equipment.
- Vessel Inspections
- Organising maintenance and repairs so that the ship is able to maintain its schedule
- Running the ships bar, stock ordering and tallying bar bills

Who are we looking for?

We are looking for an individual that has the following skills and experience:

- Minimum UK MCA Yacht 4 or SMEOL (Senior Marine Operators Licence) although higher engineering qualifications would be preferred.
- STCW Basic Safety Training (essential)
- ENG1 Medical Certificate (essential)
- Fluent in English (essential)
- DBS Certificate (desirable)
- Excellent organisation skills and the ability to manage a high volume workload in challenging conditions.
- Previous experience of working as an Engineer on a sailing vessel is desirable although not essential.
- Good communication skills
- Ability to work under pressure
