  - Personal Safety & Social Responsibilities (PSSR)
  - Elementary First Aid (EFA)
  - Fire Prevention & Fire Fighting (FPFF)
  - Proficiency in Medical Care onboard Ship (PMC)
  - Proficiency in Designated Security Duties (PDSD)
